# The "pre-modern era"

#### • Ended with the French Revolution

• God exists. Truth exists. Both are real.

• The greatest truths were supernatural.

Human knowledge was limited thus we need faith.

# The French Revolution (1789-1799)

• "dawn of the Modern Era"

- challenged authority of monarchy & church
- exalted human reason & human rights



# The Modern Era

- The Modern World
- (French Revolution 1960's)
- Humanity is progressing through science and reason.
- Belief in objective truth
- Belief in propositional truth
- The secularization of the world

### Postmoderism

- 1960' s --> ?
- Difficult to define; various definitions in various disciplines
- Transitional period (void) a worldview "in process"
- Western world in transition not sure what will be
- A belief in the "unsecularization" of the world
  - movement toward spiritual things

# Impact on Christianity

- Christianity today is often expressed in the context of the modern world view
- Postmodernism: it is arrogant (sin) to claim to know "the truth".
- Postmodernism accepts the supernatural but not as a <u>source</u> of objective truth.
- "Experience God --> then you will have the right theology."
- The church is under attack because the church is one of the few institutions in society which asserts morality and truth.

# **Beware of Truth Decay**

- What happens when new information conflicts with a previously existing belief?
- Cognitive Dissonance:
- Conflict or anxiety: when beliefs and behaviors aren't consistent.
- Your brain seeks consistency between your beliefs, our behaviors and our experience.

### Positive side of Postmodernism

- Rejection of dry orthodoxy and passionless faith
- Inclusion of feelings and emotions in matters of faith
  - (note danger of imbalance)
- Passion-driven not purpose-driven
- Value symbols and meaning (neglect commitment and sacrifice; cost of discipleship)
- Primacy of lived faith
- Centrality of Relationships
